### **Policy Objective**

The objective is to integrate environmental and energy considerations into the strategic and operational management of the ports, focusing on sustainable development, innovation, and compliance with national and international environmental standards. The aim is to transform the ports into "Green Ports" characterized by low emissions, resilience, and sustainability.

#### **Policy Description**

The DEASP covers strategic environmental and energy planning for the ports of Genova and Savona. It includes measures for reducing carbon footprints, enhancing energy efficiency, and employing advanced digital technologies to improve port operations. The plan also emphasizes the transition to alternative energy sources like LNG and hydrogen, alongside infrastructure improvements for better connectivity and reduced environmental impact.

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders.
