Waste Management

Policy Objective

The Holistic Waste Management Program aims to drastically enhance waste management in Aglantzia by incentivizing waste reduction through financial mechanisms. It seeks to convert waste generation habits by implementing a "Pay as you throw" system, encouraging residents to reduce non-recyclable waste output and increase recycling efforts.

Policy Description

The program introduces a variable pricing model where residents are charged based on the amount of non-recycled waste they produce, rather than a fixed fee. This model is designed to motivate households to minimize residual waste and segregate recyclables more effectively. The system includes the distribution of RFID-equipped waste bins that monitor waste levels and composition, facilitating precise billing and providing data to improve waste management strategies.

Project summary

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders. It focuses on continuous policy improvement and transformation, and aims to establish long-term cooperation on public policy instruments at the Euro-Mediterranean level, ultimately improving citizens' quality of life.
