Policy Objective

The objective of Barcelona's Superblocks policy is to create a healthier, greener, and safer urban environment. This initiative focuses on reclaiming public spaces for active modes and social activities, enhancing social interactions, and revitalizing the local economy by reducing vehicular traffic in designated city areas

Policy Description

Under the Superblocks policy, Barcelona transforms specific city blocks into "superblocks" that restrict car traffic to promote pedestrian use. These zones prioritize walkways, green spaces, and recreational areas, shifting the urban environment from vehicle-focused to pedestrian-centered. This restructuring aims to enhance community vitality and encourage sustainable urban practices.

Project summary

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders. It focuses on continuous policy improvement and transformation, and aims to establish long-term cooperation on public policy instruments at the Euro-Mediterranean level, ultimately improving citizens' quality of life.

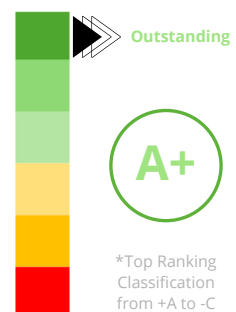
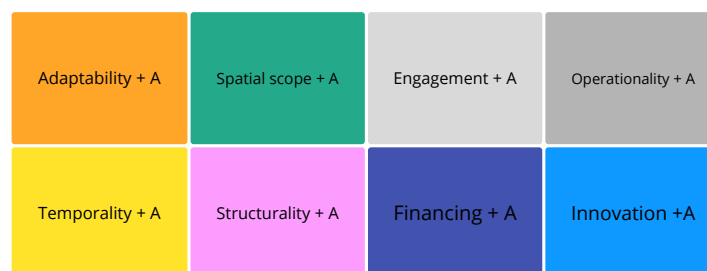
