Policy Objective

To increase the resilience of public property assets by enhancing their energy efficiency and reducing their CO2 emissions. This effort aims to make substantial contributions to the regional environmental goals and bolster both human and institutional capabilities in addressing climate change challenges.

Policy Description

E4PAREX outlines a systematic approach to retrofitting public administration buildings with advanced energy solutions to minimize their environmental impact. The strategy involves a detailed assessment of existing facilities, followed by the implementation of targeted measures such as the integration of renewable energy technologies and optimization of energy consumption. Additionally, it includes educational initiatives to foster a culture of sustainability among the public sector staff and the broader community, reinforcing the region's commitment to a green and circular economy.

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders. 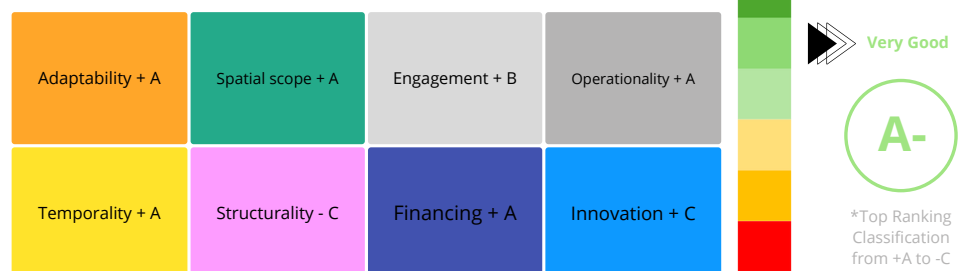
