Policy Objective

The objective of this policy is to drive the energy transition within Lombardy's socioeconomic system towards the use of renewable energy sources, aiming for net carbon neutrality by 2050, and to combat energy poverty through community-based energy solutions.

Policy Description

The policy emphasizes establishing and supporting Renewable Energy Communities (CERs) as autonomous legal entities for producing, consuming, and sharing renewable energy among members. It provides technical and financial assistance to implement energy-saving measures, develop renewable energy projects, and integrate advanced technologies such as energy storage and smart grids. Additionally, it includes educational initiatives to raise public awareness about the benefits of renewable energy and promotes environmental responsibility across the region.

Project summary

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders. 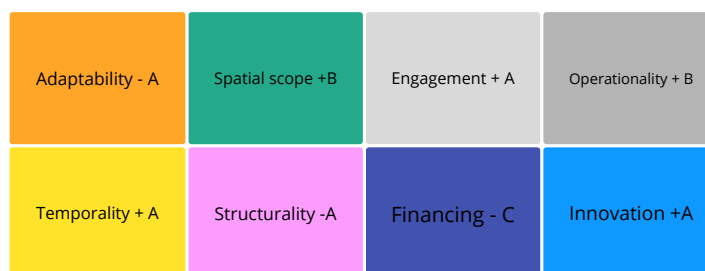
