Policy Objective

Establish a network of productive, green spaces within Seixal's urban areas to promote organic farming and ecological sustainability, targeting improved community well-being, enhanced family income, and strengthened local cultural and social bonds.

Policy Description

The initiative allocates designated municipal lands for residents to cultivate seasonal crops, focusing on organic and sustainable farming practices. It aims to integrate these spaces into the city's green infrastructure, supporting social interaction and community development while promoting healthy lifestyles and environmental awareness.

Project summary

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders. It focuses on continuous policy improvement and transformation, and aims to establish long-term cooperation on public policy instruments at the Euro-Mediterranean level, ultimately improving citizens' quality of life.

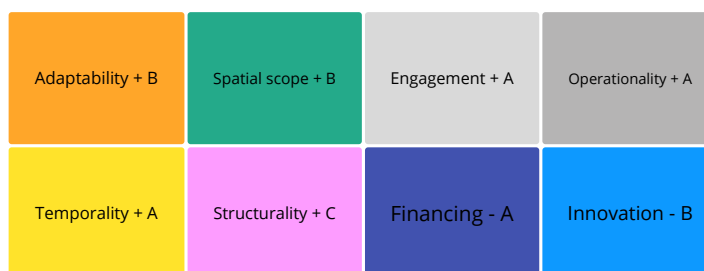
