Policy Objective

To incentivize the use of renewable energy sources (RES) by offering free electric bike and vehicle rentals to residents who install such systems.

Policy Description

This policy waives rental fees for electric bikes and vehicles for residents with RES installations. Users receive a card that allows free usage after verification via a utility bill showing the RES installation.

Project summary

The Institutional Dialogue Project of the Green Living Areas Mission seeks to enhance policy transfer through dialogue among policymakers and public stakeholders.
